

## KS2 mathematics work sheet: one- and two-step addition and subtraction

1. There were 17 bricks on one pallet, and 15 bricks on another pallet. 9 bricks were taken by builders to use on a home.



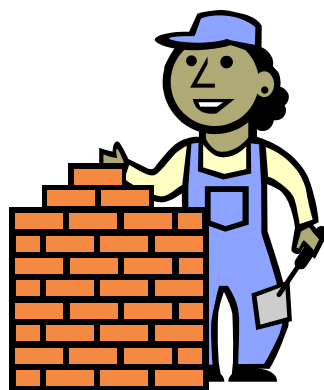
How many bricks were left on the pallets?

2. When working on a building site, people use a lot of pencils. A box of pencils holds 5 pencils when it's full. There are 2 full boxes of pencils. The builders take 4 pencils to be used while they work.



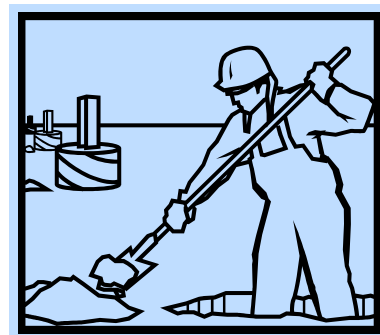
How many pencils are left?

3. There are 26 bricklayers, 18 carpenters and 12 electricians on the building site.



How many workers are there in total on the building site?

4. There are currently only 10 workers on the building site and 5 workers come to join them. 7 workers then go off the site on their lunch break.



How many workers are there left on the building site?

5. The workers build 9 houses on one part of the site and 14 houses on another part of the site. 18 houses have already been bought by families.



How many have not been bought yet?

6. 20 children were visiting the building site on a school trip. Half the children went to talk to the builders. 4 more children went to join them.

How many children were talking to the builders?
